Bill Introduction Deadline – Friday, February 21, 2025

• Total Bills Introduced: 2,350

• **Assembly**: 1,500

• **Senate**: 850

• Spot or Intent Bills: 871

FY 2025-2026 State Budget

- SB 101/ AB 102 Budget Act of 2025
 - \$321B state budget
 - Signed June 27, 2025
- AB 130 Housing (2025-2026)
 - Budget Trailer Bill
 - Signed June 30, 2025
- SB 131 Public Resources (2025-2026)
 - Budget Trailer Bill
 - Signed June 30, 2025



AB 130 Housing (2025-2026)

- Incorporated:
 - REAP 2.0 Extension SUPPORT
 - SB 681 (Wahab) Expands HCD control over RHNA processes – OPPOSE
 - AB 609 (Wicks) CEQA exemptions for infill housing - SUPPORT
 - AB 1244 (Wicks) TOD Implementation Program – WATCH



SB 131 Public Resources (2025-2026)

- Incorporated:
 - HHAP Program Funding
 - \$500M for Round 7 in FY 2026
 - CEQA Exemption for High-Speed Rail
 - SB 607 (Wiener) Fast & Focused CEQA Act – SUPPORT

Advocacy – Legislation

- LCMC 24 bill positions adopted
 - 19 Support
 - 3 Oppose
 - 2 Watch
- 52 advocacy letters submitted
- Submitting seven (7) requests for signature and one (1) request for a veto to the Governor

- Priorities
 - Codify the REAP program and provide continued funding
 - Extend REAP 2.0 expenditure deadline
 - Address resilience needs
 - Provide funding for 2028

Emerging Advocacy Priorities

- AB 1275 (Elhawary): Improved alignment between SCS and RHNA
- AB 1207 (Irwin) / SB 840 (Limon): Cap and Invest Extension
- AB 736 (Wicks) / SB 417 (Cabaldon): Housing Bond

2025 End of Session

- 2,833 bill introduced
- 1,014 2-year bills
- 418 signed by Governor this year
- 805 bills currently on Governor's desk
 - Over 500 sent in last two weeks
- October 13 Deadline for Governor to act on bills

- Senator Monique Limón (D-Santa Barbara)
- Beginning Term: November 17, 2025
- Termed out end of 2028

Looking Ahead – Cap and Invest

- SB 840 (Limón) Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund
 - Shifted funding from percentages to set funding amounts
 - Split funding into three tiers
 - Left approximately \$1B for the legislature to deliberate in 2026

- October 2024 LCMC Presentation from Bill Higgins, CalCOG
- May 7 CARB accepts SCAG's Connect SoCal 2024
- Working to identify opportunities to modernize SB 375

Look Ahead – Addressing RHNA Timeline Issues

- Bills affecting RHNA timeline this year:
 - AB 130 Housing Budget Trailer Bill
 - AB 650 (Papan): Extending RHNA timelines and providing analysis on Housing Element deficiencies
 - AB 1275 (Elhawary): Improved alignment between SCS and RHNA
 - **SB 233 (Seyarto)**: Earlier consultation between HCD and COGs
 - **SB 486 (Cabaldon)**: Accounting for postsecondary enrollment in SCS
